2.	DO NOT eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery. your morning medications with a sip of water.	DO take
3.	If you take insulin, take 1/2 of your usual dosage on the morning of your surgery.	
4.	Please wear loose-fitting, short-sleeved clothing.	
5.	Please DO NOT wear any make-up or cold cream.	
6.	You will be given some relaxing medicine for your surgery. Your eye will be patched after surgery. For these reasons, you should plan on having a DRIVER on the day of and day after your surgery.	
7.	We may need to obtain a blood test or EKG prior to surgery. We will do this at unless you are otherwise instructed.	
8.	We will give you post-operative instructions and prescribe eye drops for your use the day after your surgery.	
9.	Please call us if we need to help you arrange transportation to and We can also offer suggestions for where to stay the night after your surgery if you live far way.	
10.	lease call us if you develop a fever or red eye prior to your surgery date. We may need to estpone your surgery.
